- Umstieg für Windows- und Mac-Nutzer in der Regel unproblematisch

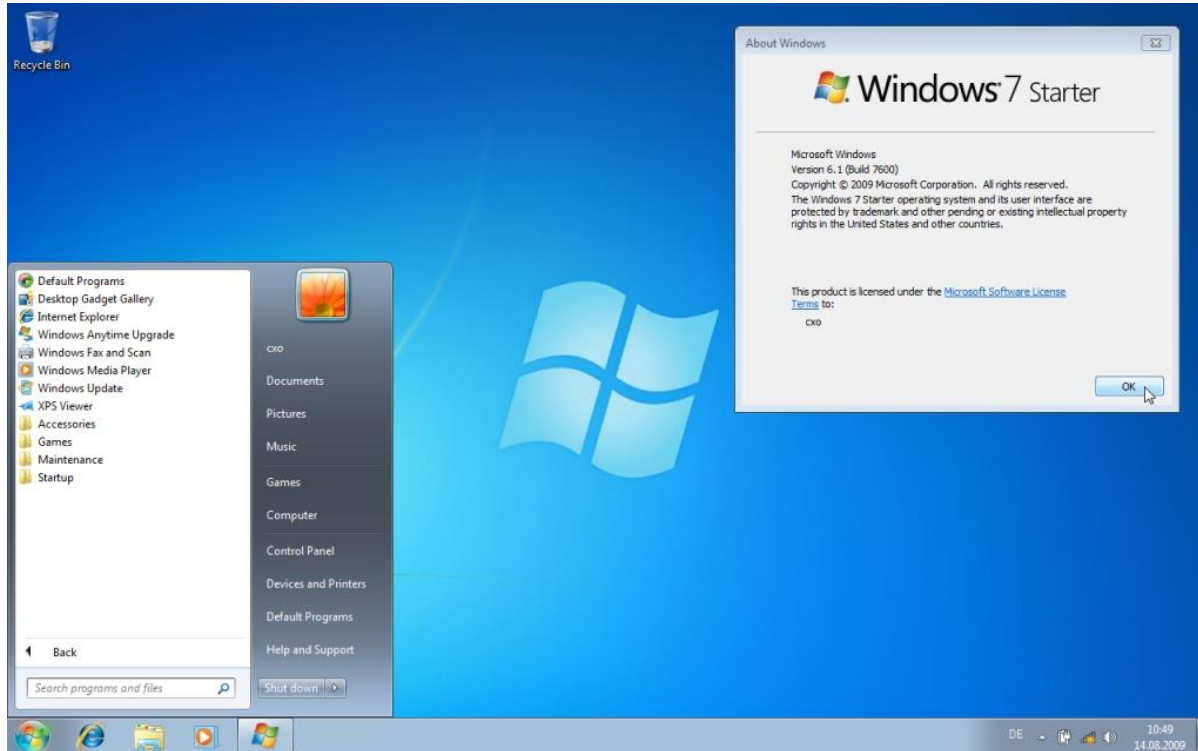

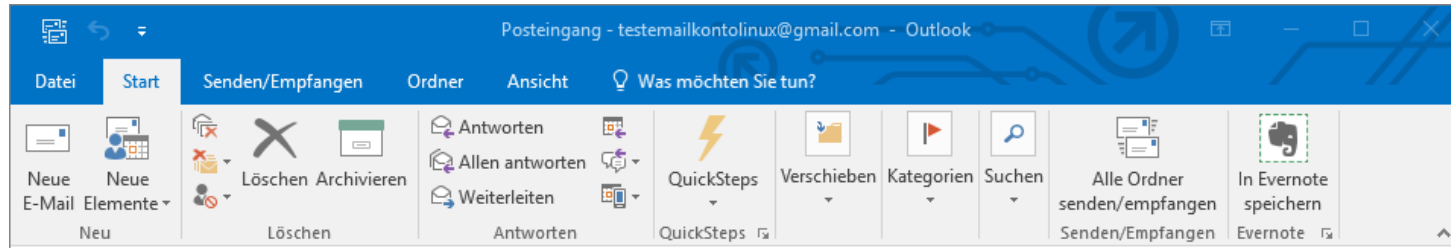

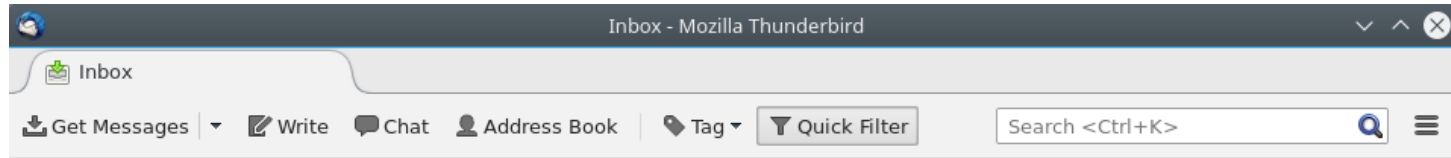

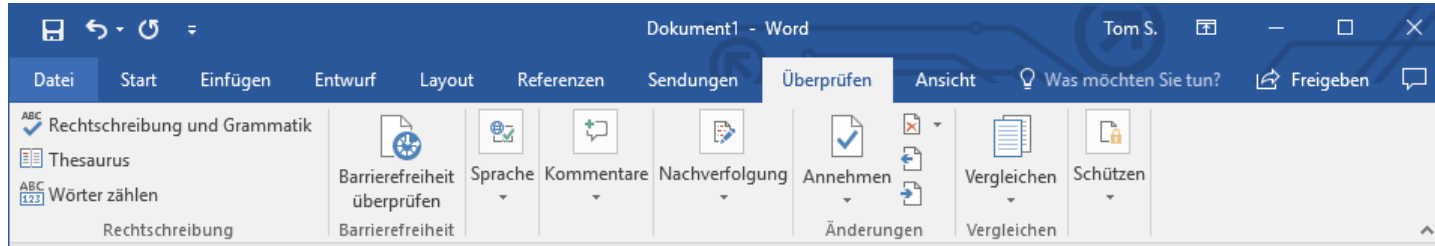

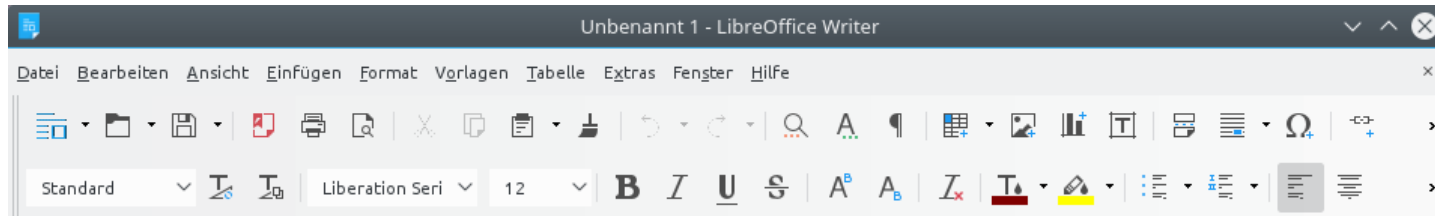
